	Youth Services: Offers programs, awareness presentations and special events with the FCSS Youth Programmer, drop in activities with Youth Crew ages 10 to 17
	Leaders of Tomorrow and Dylan Stork Youth Ambassador Awards: A youth volunteer recognition program that recognizes students who have made outstanding contributions to our community through volunteerism
	Rainbows: Bereavement support group for children facing loss owing to death or divorce
	Back to School Program: Assists children with required school supplies. Partnership with Women’s Outreach to provide some necessary school items, backpacks and shoes
	Alberta Health Services Youth Mental Health: Office space at the FCSS building to provide mental health services to youth in partnership with schools in the community
	Big Brothers Big Sister of Blackfalds: Provides mentorship, Kids & Kops program, Big Bunch events, camp subsidies and adopt a family
Families	Christmas Bureau: Program that provides toys, gifts & food hampers to families experiencing financial difficulties during the Christmas season
	Child Care: Facilitate courses that strengthen families provide babysitting courses shared office space with Kids Konnection Razzle Dazzle licensed family day home
	Iron Ridge Elementary Campus School Social Worker Program: Provides crisis support and proactive programming to students, families and community members
	Village Gate Parent Link Outreach: Programs for parents and young children, parent education and information connecting parents to parents
Adults	Employment Supports: Job board updated weekly and resume assistance
	Information and Referrals: Supporting community members to access services as needed
Seniors	Snow shovelling program: Program that utilizes volunteers to assist seniors with snow removal
	Intergenerational Programming: In partnership with Kid Konnection we offer biannual events to engage seniors and children in various activities together
	Senior Home Support: Accessing support to seniors in need by partnering with existing program provided by Lacombe FCSS
Community Development	BOLT Blackfalds & Lacombe Transit: Provides public transportation to and from Red Deer and Lacombe allowing residents to access more services outside of the community
	Volunteer Services: Promotes volunteerism in the community refers potential volunteers to volunteer opportunities available in the community organizes annual community volunteer appreciation event collaborative partnerships with local organizations
