For the past several years an annual municipal census has been conducted followed by the creation of a census report. The reason for doing this is that the Town of Blackfalds continues to see population growth that is well above the provincial average – now for nine consecutive years!

The data collected from the municipal census is invaluable for our growing community. The results are used to access population-based funding, which means more dollars to allocate to the programs and services that the Town delivers to residents and businesses.

This year's municipal census was conducted between May I and June 30, both online (40% of respondents) and door-to-door (60% of respondents), providing a 99.5% census completion rate.

Thanks to all Blackfalds residents who completed the census. I look forward to being a part of the continued growth of the community through the year and into 2018.

The Municipal Census is collected under the authority of the Alberta's Municipal Government Act (MGA). The collection of personal information is authorized by Section 33(c) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP). Household data collected is deemed confidential and never released at an individual resident level.

### 2017 at a Glance - Sustainable Growth

For the ninth year in a row, Blackfalds has displayed above Provincial average growth with an annual population increase of 4.27% along with a 5.84% gain in dwellings.

This year the Town's population increased by 406, bringing the current number of residents to 9.916 from the 2016 population of 9,510. Blackfalds' 2017 growth rate is significantly higher than Alberta estimated average growth rate for the year of 1.51%\*.

Since 2007, the community has seen a 105% increase in population. While this year does represent a slowdown in growth compared with the 8.15% population increase in 2016, the community is still more than double the provincial average.

# **A Growing Family Community**

Blackfalds is a community with a strong base of young and growing families - with the largest age group being those aged 19-40 (42%) and a weighted average age of 30, significantly younger than the provincial median of 36.7\*.

Over 73% of those living in Blackfalds are 40 years of age or younger, with 33% being 20 years of age or younger.

The largest single demographic in Blackfalds is those aged 0-5, with a population of 1,185 or 13%.

Inversely, the smallest demographic is those aged 65+, representing 320 individuals or 3.2%.


## **Something to Dwell About**



The number of dwellings in Blackfalds has continued increasing in 2017 from 4,095 to 4,349 which is an increase of 254 units or 5.84%.

Current residential development includes a 3-storey, 27 unit apartment complex, condominiums, and a manufactured home park, showing a strong mix of different dwelling types for a diverse community.

## **An Educated, Young Workforce**

Those between the ages of 21 - 65 comprise 63% of Blackfalds total population\*. Census data indicates that 58% of respondents are employed on a full time permanent basis\*. 7% reported being **FULL-TIME** employed on a part time basis, 6% identified as self-employed, 12% indicated attending school full time, and 8% declared being stay at 58% of the working home caregivers. population of respondents (3,900) are employed on a 59% of Blackfalds residents reported having completed postfull time permanent basis secondary education\* - including registered trade certificates, college diplomas and university degrees. 

## **A Broad Range of Occupations**

Out of 4,431 employed respondents, the majority reported working in trades (1,229), natural resources (907), and sales and service (658), followed by a close split between occupations in education, law, government, health, business, finance and administration (for a total of 1,637).

# **Household Earnings**

Among respondents that declared their annual household income, the large majority (70.6%) were within the range of \$45,282 to \$140,388, with 37.2% declaring between \$45,282 and \$90,563 and 33.5% declaring between \$90,563 and \$140,388. This falls in line with the provincial median family income of \$100,300\*.

18.6% of households reported exceeding \$140,388 in annual income while only 10.6% disclosed earning \$45,282 or less.












