Dr. and Mrs. Kauchali presented to Council on a number of challenges the Apollo Health Clinic has faced over the preceding 2 years in the recruitment of new doctors to the clinic.

Council directed Administration to draft and send letters to our MLA and Health Minister to lend support for Apollo Clinic's initiative to bring more doctors to Blackfalds.

In addition, Council was unanimous in moving to create an emergent resolution with Alberta Municipalities in conjunction with neighbouring municipalities in regard to this issue to ensure a resolution comes forward.
