DELEGATIONS

Provincial Legislative Update

MLA Jennifer Johnson (Lacombe–Ponoka) provided Council with current provincial updates.

IRSC Graduation Awards & Scholarships Program

Representatives from Iron Ridge Secondary Campus presented a request related to the school's 2026 graduation awards and scholarships.

U18A Provincial Hockey Championship

Blackfalds Minor Hockey provided an update on the upcoming U18A Hockey Alberta Provincial Championship to be hosted at the Eagle Builders Centre from March 26–29, 2026.

RCMP Community Priorities Plan 2026

Council supported the RCMP's 2026 Community Priorities Plan process and will engage residents through public consultation activities during February.

Friends of the Blindman River

Council directed Administration to seek clarification from Red Deer River Municipal Users Group and the Red Deer River Watershed Alliance on potential conflicts related to participation in the Friends of the Blindman River Committee.

Council also approved half-day per diem and mileage for Councillors Hanson and Twerdoclib to attend the Our Waters event on February 25, 2026.
