CONSENT AGENDA

Council adopted the Consent Agenda for June 23, 2026, including approval of previous meeting minutes, Council and administrative reports, and other informational items. The CAO Report was postponed to the July 14, 2026 Regular Council Meeting.

PUBLIC HEARING

Aspen Lakes West Phase 2A Redistricting – Bylaw 1358.26

Council held a Public Hearing regarding the proposed redistricting of Aspen Lakes West Phase 2A. One speaker spoke in favour of the Bylaw and no opposition was presented.
